### Vocabulary

**Democracy** - A way a country is run when the power and choices are made by the people, not just the leader.

**Parliament** - A group of people who make laws for a country.

**Party** - A group of people who believe in the same thing.

### Rights and Responsibilities

**Democracy** - Children have many opportunities to be heard. They learn about and take an active role in democratic processes such as the school council, eco council, prefects.

### The Rule of Law -

Understand the value and need for laws and that they are there for our own safety. Understand right from wrong and that there are consequences for wrong.
